Hsiao-hung Nancy Chen, former Chair & Dean of the Department of Sociology & the College of Social Sciences, National Chengchi University in Taipei, Taiwan, is currently serving as Member of the Control Yuan, Republic of China aside from being Professor Emeritus of the National Chengchi University. Prior to her current ministerial-level appointment, she has served as the Senior Advisor to the President of the Republic of China and Deputy Minister of the Council for Economic Planning & Development (now is called the National Development Council) of the Executive Yuan.

She earned her Ph. D. from the University of Pittsburgh in the area of Economic & Social Development in 1977. She has ever since taught in several universities at home and abroad. Her areas of interest ranges from the Sociology of Development, Urban & Regional Planning, Social Welfare Policies to Contemporary Chinese Society. Besides newspaper columns, Dr. Chen has published more than 250 articles and chapters/books so far. She has been awarded as the best teacher by the Ministry of Education and granted Fulbright visiting scholar to the University of Chicago. She also acted as visiting scholars to MIT and Oxford. In addition to teaching and research, Dr. Chen serves extensively as policy consultant to various governmental committees and NGOs as well.
